Report on Dzongkha Linux Training conducted by private IT training institutes

Introduction

The Department of Information Technology has outsourced the Dzongkha Linux Training to the private IT training institutes in view of the fact that the department may not be able to reach all the target user groups on its own. The department conducted a training of trainers from 19th to 27th November, 2007. The training of trainers program was attended by sixteen people from various IT institutes and government organizations. After the training of trainers, the department has awarded recognition to three IT training institutes, one each in the southern, eastern and central/western part of the country, as the centers for Dzongkha Linux training.
