# 1 Introduction

This document explains how to install and un-install *Banglapad*.

## 2 Installation Prerequisite

### 2.1 Hardware Requirements

Platform: PC  
Processor: Pentium 2 133 MHz  
Memory: 16 MB

### 2.2 Software Requirements

Operating Systems: Windows, Linux, and Mac OS X  
Language Settings: Unicode  
Font Settings: Bangla Open Type fonts  
Java Runtime Environment (JRE): 1.4.2 +

### 2.3 Administrator Privileges

Required for installing fonts

## 3 Installation of

Please follow the steps given below to install Banglapad (Linux and Mac OS X):

1. The utility software is an executable JAR file. Simply clicking the JAR file would start the program or running the following command from command prompt will also run the program.

```
$ java -jar Banglapad.jar
```

Please follow the steps given below to install Banglapad (Windows):

1. For windows we have an installer that installs the necessary fonts in the PC and installs the software, Banglapad.
2. User can get this software installed by clicking the Setup.exe




Figure: Setup.exe in the folder. By clicking this installation procedure will start.

3. Simple clicking installation procedure will lead to a complete installation of Banglapad with necessary Free Bangla fonts.




Figure: Installation procedure of Banglapad




Figure: Installing Banglapad

4. After successful installation of Banglapad an icon will be placed in the Program Files and another in the desktop (if user wishes to).




Figure: Banglapad icon in Program Files

5. Starting Banglapad




Figure: After clicking the Banglapad icon the editor will start

1. Click the uninstall icon in the Banglapad installation folder or in the Program Files.




Figure: Uninstall in the Program Files




Figure: Uninstalling Banglapad
