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1 Introduction

Khmer Unicode Conversion is an application generated specifically for converting non-Unicode font based on Microsoft Office document as well as text file format into Unicode font. This document explains how to use this application.

2 Running the Application

After the successful installation and all its dependencies, you can run Khmer Unicode conversion by clicking “**Khmer Conversion**” button that already embedded to Microsoft Office application.




Figure 1: Microsoft Word Conversion Application

3 Using Application

1. Convert Microsoft Word Document

After clicking “**Khmer Conversion**” button:

1. Click “**Browse**” to point to document to be converted
2. Click “**Save As**” to set output file(in case you don't want to get default output file, automatically generate after clicking “**Browse**” button)
3. Click on “**To Unicode**” button to process conversion
4. After the conversion, there is a message “The document has converted completely!” Click “**OK**” button then the converted file is loaded.




Figure 2: Khmer Unicode Conversion Microsoft Office

2. Convert text files

To run Stand Alone Application (Khmer Unicode Conversion)

1. Click “Start Menu”
2. Programs
3. Khmer Unicode Application
4. Click “Unicode Conversion” and “Switched box” will appear on screen
5. Choose “Khmer Conversion(Text file)” option
6. Click “OK”




Figure 3: To Stand Alone Application

To Use Khmer Conversion (Text file)

1. Click “Browse” to point to Text file to be converted
2. Click “Save As” to set output file (in case you don’t want to get default output file, automatically generate after clicking “Browse” button)
3. Choose particular font (Limon, ABC, ABC Zero SPACE, Khek Family, FK Family)
4. Click “To Unicode” button.




Figure 5: Text files Unicode Conversion

Convert by Copy/Paste Text

In **Selection Board**, choose “Khmer Conversion (Copy/Paste)” and Click “OK” button:

1. Type or Paste the non-Unicode text into the Non-Unicode Text Content Box
2. Choose particular font (Limon, ABC, ABC Zero SPACE, Khek Family, FK Family)
3. Click “To Unicode” button
